Dress Code

Boys: Year 7-11

- Huddersfield Grammar School Blazer
- Charcoal trousers (not Black) slim fit or standard fit only, (no drainpipes, or tight trousers allowed)
- Navy pullover with logo
- White shirt with logo (long sleeve winter and short sleeve summer)
- Striped tie (Yr 7-10)
- Navy/white shirt (Yr 11 Only)
- Plain blue tie (Yr 11 only)
- Plain black or dark grey socks
- Coat, plain navy or black, no logos or trim (not school specific)
- School bag (not school specific, but large enough to carry an A4 ring binder)
- Sports bag (not school specific)
- Black Leather shoes, which can be polished (no trainers, vans or canvas shoes)

Dress Code

At Huddersfield Grammar School we are committed to supporting the ethos and expectations of the school, our school uniform is part of the school's identity therefore we would like all students to maintain the following standards;

- Shirts should be tucked in, top button fastened and ties to reach the waist band. If Blazers are removed, the shirt must contain the embroidered school crest.
- For boys, trousers should be charcoal grey (not Black) and not tight skinny fit or drainpipes. For girls, trousers should be the school specific navy trousers with the HGS logo.
- Skirts should be on or below the knee and no shorter. To allow for movement and modesty, skirts should not be too tight. The rolling of skirts is not permitted in school. (Please be aware when purchasing skirts to give appropriate growing length.)
- Blazers should be worn at all times, unless permission is given by staff not to do so, or the Headteacher gives permission in hot weather conditions.
- Shoes to be black leather school shoes with flat heels and able to be polished. Plain black, navy or dark grey socks for boys. For girls, navy socks with trousers or navy opaque tights with skirts.
- Predominately plain dark coloured outdoor coat with no logo. Please be advised that fashion hoodies and sports attire are no substitute for coats and will not be permitted around the site at break time or lunch. Cardigans, sweatshirts, denims, baseball caps, leather jackets, hooded tops and other casual/ fashion items are not permitted.

We would recommend that parents label and 'name' all of their children's clothing.

We ask that all students adhere to the hair, make up and jewellery agreements in school, we ask for parental support in maintaining these high standards. Failure to follow these standards may result in your child being sent home to resolve the situation.

Make up & Jewellery Agreement

- Senior School students are permitted to wear gold or silver (3mm) plain stud ear-rings only. Only one pair of earrings allowed, with a single earring situated in each lobe (first hole). Any other body, cartilage and facial piercings are not allowed in school.
- Other items of jewellery should not be worn to school with the exception of watches and discreet religious symbols.
- Nail varnish and nail extensions are not permitted.
- Natural makeup can be worn in Years 10 and 11 only. The criteria, which has been agreed with the School Council and the following is allowed:
 - Concealer, foundation, tinted moisturiser, powder - of a colour in line with your natural colouring (no orange lines)
 - Natural blusher
 - Lipbalm, or tinted lipbalm in line with natural lip colour – No Lipsticks or Lip Glosses
 - Basic brown or black mascara. No lash extending mascara, false lash style mascara and no thickening mascara

The following are not permitted;

- Eye liner, false eyelashes, lipsticks, coloured lip glosses, coloured lip tints, lip liners, eye shadows, glitter foundations or blushers. In summary, anything above the natural look.

Hair Agreement

- No extremes in styling, length or colour of hair. Only in Year 10 & 11 will hair dye be permitted and it must be of a natural colour, e.g. blonde, brown or black (No grey or silver). Excessive two-toned styles are not permitted. Shaved heads are not permitted and neither are shaved patterns in hair.
- Hair should be smart and tidy. Hair length or less than grade 3 is not permitted. If hair extends beyond the collar, it should be tied back. Facial Hair is not permitted.
- Natural style, fringe, hair length should not impede their own learning or those around them.
- Hair must be not overtly styled with products.
